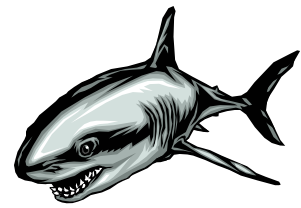




Function of Parts of a Shark



Draw a line from the part of a shark to the description of its function.

Mouth

Makes the shark stable and prevents it from rolling.

Ampullae of Lorenzini

Gets oxygen from the water and water exits the body from here.

Gill slits

Used for steering and turning.

Lateral Line

Pushes the shark forward.

Caudal Fin

Food and water enter the body here.

Pectoral Fins

Senses vibrations, pressure changes and movement in the water.

Dorsal Fin

Senses electrical signals from other animals.
