



Helpful Hints for Teachers Visiting the Rocky Shore

Useful equipment to take to the rocky shore:

- Rocky shore identification chart/book
- Camera
- Rubbish bag to collect shore litter
- Underwater viewer spyglasses
- Magnifying glass
- Large tarp for sitting on and making as 'home base'.
- First aid kit

Please minimise the disturbance of the seashore community
during your study.

Make sure your students understand the seashore code before taking
them down to the shore.

THE SEASHORE CODE

- Observe marine species where you find them.
- Make sure you have wet hands when touching marine species. Handle marine species carefully, gently and only when necessary.
- Lift rocks rather than roll them to ensure that you don't crush the marine species. Remember to turn rocks back the way you have found them.
- Wear appropriate footwear and watch the waves!
- Take your rubbish home with you and pick up any left by others.
